RAPTOR and SME Market Expansion Open Calls



Main aspects to consider:

- **SME Market Expansion Call:** Supports the supply of urban mobility innovations by helping SMEs test, improve, and commercialise solutions with real-world end-client validation (min. TRL 7)
- City RAPTOR: Addresses the demand for urban mobility solutions by rapidly developing and piloting innovations that solve city-defined challenges through direct collaboration with cities



Consortium: Mono beneficiary – for startups and SMEs from EU Member States or associated countries to HE



Mandatory elements: KPIs EITHE2.4 (marketed innovation); and contribution to EIT Urban Mobility Financial Sustainability Mechanism (FSM).



Start dates: Tentative

• SME ME Call: October 2025 City

RAPTOR: January 2026



Project duration:

• **SME ME Call**: 7 months

• City RAPTOR: 5 months



Budget:

• **SME ME Call**: up to 892.500€

• **City RAPTOR**: up to 600.000€





Launch date: June 2025

Deadline: September 2025



Main aspects to consider: Seeking new innovations that tackle the most pressing urban mobility challenges. Solutions should demonstrate strong potential for scalability and market adoption. Projects should foster collaborative innovation whether across the value chain or other strategic partnerships- with a clear pathway to market deployment by the project's end.



Consortium: Minimum of 2 partners from 2 different EU Member States or associated countries to HE.



Mandatory elements: KPIs EITHE2.4 (marketed innovation) or EITHE4.4 (startup created); minimum 35% co-funding and contribution to EIT Urban Mobility Financial Sustainability Mechanism (FSM).



Start date: Jan-Feb 2026

Project duration: up to 24 months





RIS Joint Innovation program with ADRVest in Romania Open Call 2025

Venture building and start up support in Romanian Region West

The first stage, led by EIT Urban Mobility, aims to activate the local innovation ecosystem that will implement two parallel paths:

- one for established startups and
- a second venture-building program targeting idea holders to create new startups based on a business idea responding to a specific need in a specific urban mobility field.

EIT funding allocated is €400,000 for 2025

Call opening: 17 January 2025

Call closure: 17 March 2025 at 17:00 CET







Cognata: Safety digital twin for smart cities

Award-winning 4D urban safety planning tool for "Vision Zero" Initiatives.

Solution for road safety Enables to test

- different traffic and safety scenarios,
 identify potential hazards
 examine infrastructure alternatives to reduce the risk of accidents,
- balance safety and traffic flow for all road users
